

CUCB - Extraordinary Amendment to Standard Gig Policy

Details

This is an amendment to the CUCB Standard Gig Policy, the policy applied to all non-May-Ball gigs undertaken by CUCB, which can be viewed at <https://www.cucb.co.uk/docs/standard-gig-policy.pdf>. It is applicable to cancellation requests which are made to the band between 3rd June 2021 and 10th February 2022. The amendment is proposed in response to the current UK government advice with regards to the novel coronavirus COVID-19, which currently states that everyone should avoid indoor gatherings of more than 6 people (or 2 households) and outdoor gatherings of more than 30 people.

Amendment to Section 4 of CUCB Standard Gig Policy

Amendments are indicated in *bold italics*

4. 4.1 Cancellations up to 2 weeks in advance of the agreed date will result in a full refund of the deposit. Cancellations after this point will lose their deposit.
 - 4.1.1 *Exceptions to this are made for cancellation requests made after 3rd June 2021. In this case, cancellation at any period in advance of the agreed date will result in a full refund of the deposit. This may either be paid back to the client directly, or carried forward as the deposit for a re-booking of the gig at some point in the future, at the client's request.*
- 4.2 In the unlikely event that the band has to cancel a booking, a full refund will be provided and a replacement band sought on the client's behalf if requested.
 - 4.2.1 *CUCB will not play any gig that contradicts the most current government advice. In this case, CUCB will contact the client in advance of the agreed date and offer a full refund of the deposit. This may either be paid back to the client directly or carried forward as the deposit for a rebooking of the gig at some point in the future, at the client's request.*
